Initial position

- 1972 Convention for the protection of the World Cultural and Natural Heritage
- 1993 Austria: ratification of the convention
- 1999 Inscription of the City of Graz to the UNESCO World Heritage list
- 2006 30th WHC in Vilnius decision: Management Plan for Graz obligatory
- 2007 Management Plan submitted to the UNESCO World Heritage Centre/Paris
 31st WHC in Christchurch decision: "noted with satisfaction"



Master Plan – cartographic depiction of the World Heritage property


- Scientific basis for the protection, planning and development matters in the historic centre of Graz.

Objectives of the WH-MP 2007

- Concept for the future approach to the Word Heritage Historic Centre of Graz
- Operational Guideline containing measures which guarantee the further development of the Historic Centre in the spirit of World Heritage interests
- Super-ordinate objectives
 - ✓ self-commitment for the city of Graz
 - ✓ WH-topic as a cross-sectional matter (WH co-ordination)



World Heritage co-ordination office (WH-office)

- ✓ integrated to the existing structure of Graz
- ✓ Information interface/first contact
- ✓ Co-ordination interface for all World Heritage activities
- ✓ Pre-information service for project sponsors/investors
- ✓ Public relation for the World Heritage



Obligation to register with WH-office

normal case

no construction process yet:

- pre-qualification with the WH-office
- achieving a joint agreement with special departments

special case

construction process was initiated:

- serious conflict with the interests of World Heritage
- the preliminary service of the WHoffice was not used

step-by-step information:



- consultant of the committee of Graz City Council
- political committee
- state party and WHC/Paris



EXAMPLE:

Project which is likely to disturb WH HIGH EMERGENCY

1st **step:** WH-office/co-ordination:

authority - experts - applicants

aim: finding a solution in early stage of project

2nd step: relevant politicians are given a possibility to intervene

on behalf of World Heritage

3rd step: written report to the responsible political committee

4th **step:** information to:

 Federal Ministry for Education, Arts and Culture (BMUKK)

- World Heritage Centre (WHC) UNESCO/Paris
