- communication and dissemination of results on local and project level.

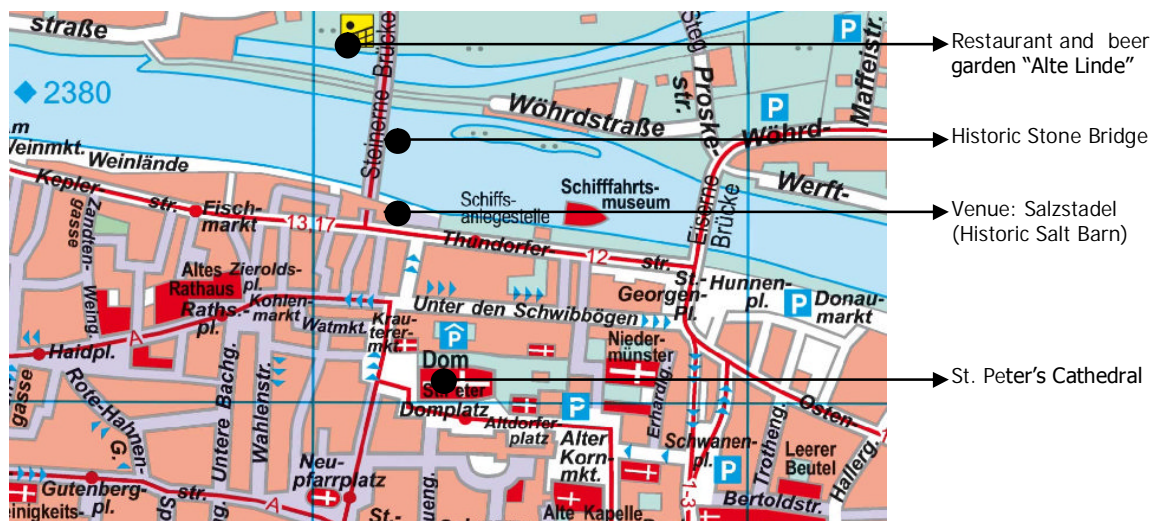
